Capella State School Uniform Policy Supported by Capella State School P&C Association

- Girls Uniform:** Maroon and white checked dress or school polo shirt worn with maroon skorts, pleated skirt or shorts (*sports briefs or bike pants should be worn under dresses or skirts*)
Black closed in shoes or joggers with maroon and/or white socks
- Boys Uniform:** School polo shirt worn with maroon shorts
Black closed in shoes or joggers with maroon and white or grey socks
- Winter Uniform:** Maroon tracksuit and/or grey or maroon skivi or tights worn under regular uniform
- Hats:** Maroon broad brimmed hats must be worn whenever outside the classroom. Akubra's, branded bucket hats and caps are not a suitable hat to be worn at school
- Sports Shirts:** Students are encouraged to wear their sports house coloured polo on their class PE day and at our school sports days
- Hair Accessories:** Hair accessories should only be worn in the school colours
- Jewellery:** The only jewellery appropriate for school is simple stud or sleeper earrings and a medic alert bracelet or necklace. All other jewellery should be removed before coming to school

Jeans, thongs, sandals, make-up and fingernail polish are not appropriate for school

The school community together with the P&C Association are striving to ensure the highest possible standards at the school. We are seeking your support to maintain these standards by ensuring your child wears the correct uniform at all times. Students who repeatedly wear non uniform items will be required to change into spare items at school.



Manufacturer Garment/Fabric Care:

Polos

We recommend a "cold wash" across all polo fabrics. Many of our garments are multi-coloured, so a cold wash will minimise colour run and also prolong the life of the garment. Some older stock may state a warm wash on the tag. We are now however recommending a "cold wash". We also recommend that garments are hung up inside out to air dry. If tumbling is required use the cool setting. Ironing should not be required, but if so, use a cool iron inside out.

Dresses/Skorts

Polyviscose will not retain its firmness above 60 degrees Celsius, so wash these products in cold water where possible. A cool iron inside out is recommended.

Fading

To minimise fading please dry inside out

Colourfastness

In order to avoid any colour running, we recommend a cold wash. If there is some colour run, it will usually disappear over the next couple of washes. Please wash with "like colours".

Staining

Please do not bleach our garments; this will cause colours to run. We recommend the use of 'Sard Spray' to spot out any severe stains – do this on a couple of washes and it should disappear.

Prints

Some schools use waterbase prints and others plastisol – to avoid any risk do not iron the print directly. If ironing is required please iron inside out.
